





## 4 Description of the proposed works

Open up the top of the well by removing the topsoil in the area of subsidence just sufficient to reveal the void cause by the subsidence of the existing soil fill and to provide access to tip in the granular fill.

Infill the void in the well with granular DOT type 1 clean aggregate tipped in and lightly compacted.

Replacement of original top soil to suitable depth and seed with grass.

Finished surface level to be brought up to existing surrounding levels.

Arrange archaeological recording of any well structure which might be exposed during the works.
