Subject: Outdoor Fitness Equipment

Dear Allison

Apologies for the long delay in coming back to you on this issue.

We have discussed the proposal from Oakham Town Council that the new outdoor fitness equipment should be located on the Royce's Recreation ground. I'm afraid that the intention for the equipment was to increase the level of provision of fitness equipment in the town, both in terms of the number of sites where equipment could be accessed, and the actual amount of equipment available for use. Replacing the existing equipment on the same site isn't unfortunately something we would be able to support.

Can I ask that the Council reconsider the original proposal of siting the equipment on the Centenary Field opposite Lidl? I believe that OTC decisions can't be reviewed within 6 months of a decision being made, would it be possible for this to be considered in January or February?

If Oakham Town Council does not wish for the equipment to be installed on its land, an alternative would be for the equipment to be offered to other parishes in the County by raising the opportunity at the Parish Forum. If you would prefer us to do this, please let me know,
