McDonald's today met with Councillor Webb, who raised the issue of a lack of litter bins in the surrounding wider area to the proposed restaurant.

Whilst we do not consider that it is McDonald's responsibility to either provide or empty such bins. McDonald's are providing sufficient bins within the site. However, should the offsite provision be required and justified in accordance with the Framework, McDonald's would be will to pay a commuted sum for the council to provide and empty bins within a reasonable distance of the proposed restaurant. We would not want to be party to any going requirements nor any detailed discussion of type, location etc, as long as the requirement can be justified, and the principle established.
