Immediately we need to replace 2 defibs approx. £2200 (worked to raise money for the others already replaced and need to replace the last 2 which are now 7/8 years old.)

Very soon we will also need to replace the one with a Responder who for personal reasons is currently, temporarily stood down.

We usually have a reserve stock of observation equipment for when a piece breaks in order to keep each responder on the road. However now put them into use so need to obtain
