What do you want to do?

We are a social enterprise who run various community projects for all around nature, food and the environment - nurturing the community through nature.

We have a 1.5 acre community garden based at The Rutland Showground where we host volunteering days and workshops to manage the growing and caring for the garden and community who spend time with us.

We plan to extend the days we operate from just a Wednesday to a weekend as well to encourage more people to utilise the space. This entails a cost for a coordinator for the day and some resource costs. We would also like to purchase some specialist tools to enable access for all our volunteers and also child sized tools.

What difference will your project make?

Our shared garden is a place that people can come to have a friendly chat and a cup of tea and get involved with gardening. We grow vegetables, fruit and flowers which all have a purpose. We share our harvests and if there is a surplus, we take it to our Community Fridges in Oakham and Uppingham, to share among our customers.

We host a weekly volunteer session which connects people to their local environment and community. We grow produce that we can later use in workshops ie Calendula flowers for salve making, to build learning, purpose and skills.

Having a shared garden means that people who are unable to have their own allotment or growing space can access a community garden where people work together for common good.

Our shared garden promotes Community and Nature connection. Being a green space, open to all, means that networks amongst people are developed and a sense of ownership is fostered to consider sustainability for people and place.
