Email correspondence from Oakham Home Gardens and Allotment Society (OHGAS)

I have taken over as secretary for OHGAS and I have been asked to forward this onto you so that it can be taken to the Council for permission and to see if they will contribute towards the new gates that will be installed.

Subject: Willow fencing

Please find attached prices for fencing and gates etc for the Willow Crescent security improvements.

The gates are obviously for one off and the price of the fencing is for 7 off x 12.5 metre rolls.

In addition to these prices there will be incidental costs such as fixings, post concrete and lock and chain which I estimate to be approx £150-£200.

The total estimated cost is about £1500-£2000

The basic reason for this is to improve security at the site as we have had instances of vandalism which have necessitated calling the police on several occasions.

The idea is to remove the existing wooden fence leaving the concrete posts in situ and attaching new steel posts (already in our possession) to them and then fitting 6ft high chain link fencing and also replacing the existing wooden gates with new steel mesh gates and posts. All of this would be along the line of the existing fence and gates.

We would like to know from the Town Council if this is ok, and also what they want doing with the removed wooden fence and gates which belong to them?

Also, if they would be willing to contribute to the cost of materials?

The work itself would be done by ourselves, (I already have several volunteers).
