We would like to start a craft group for children in Rutland who are socially isolated and struggling with school and peer relationships. We would like to use creativity and nature as ways to help children grow in self confidence, communication skills and connecting with others.

Children who have struggled with their mental health during lockdown, or have had significant difficulties at school, and those whose parents have withdrawn from school because of unhappiness and are educating them at home.

What difference will your project make?

We think that such a group will be a bridge into connecting with the outside world and with others that some children are in desperate need of.
