
### What is the UK Shared Prosperity Fund?

- Previous Government 'Levelling Up' scheme and replacement of EU funding
- All areas of the UK receiving an allocation from the Fund via a funding formula rather than a competition.
- Overarching objective = Building pride in place and increasing life chances
- 3 investment priorities:
  - Community and Place
  - Supporting Local Business; and
  - People and Skills
- Deadline to spend: 31 March 2025

Capital funding: £30,000 Revenue funding: £24,000

### Revenue examples/ideas:

- Town events Christmas events?
- Town campaigns and promotions shop local etc. billboard near the train station
- Painting/refresh of signs
- Wrap of empty units
- Window dressing Olympics, Christmas etc.
