To seek Council approval for the allocation of the remaining £5,486 of UK Shared Prosperity Fund (UKSPF) revenue funding and to ensure that the funding is fully utilised before the expenditure deadline of 30 September 2026, after which any unspent balance will be lost. Suggested use of the funds: Summer Concerts Programme The Summer Concerts Programme has incurred additional safeguarding costs that were not anticipated when the original budget was established. These measures are necessary to ensure the safe delivery of the events and compliance with current safeguarding requirements. It is therefore proposed that £2,706 of the remaining UKSPF funding could be allocated to the Summer Concerts Programme to cover these additional costs. This allocation would enable the Council to meet the safeguarding requirements without placing additional pressure on existing Council budgets.
