These events are low-risk and community-focused. With no alcohol sales on site (bar 2 dates), and no high-energy activities, the foreseeable clinical risk profile is limited to minor presentations: blisters, minor cuts and grazes, insect stings, and the occasional faint - particularly in warm weather.

With a peak attendance of less than 500, but expected to be between 2-300, most dates fall within Purple Guide Tier 1. At this tier, a dedicated first aid resource is appropriate. A FREC 3 responder fulfils this role - they are a capable provider able to manage the full range of anticipated presentations, stabilise any unexpected serious incident, and coordinate with 999 services where needed.
