

AGENDA ITEM 18 – STONE CARVING FOR PUBLIC CONVENIENCES

A resident has very kindly offered to carve a stone for the WCs free of charge. The stone is approx. 300m x300mm and is Clipsham limestone so fairly local.



Council would need to install the stone. The resident has advised that the stone is thick enough for existing rubble walling to be removed and the stone to be fixed in the removed stones place so that it is flush with the wall line.
